


A PLACE TO BEGIN AGAIN

"This program continues to be a life-changing experience for me on many levels. In a very short period, both my physical and mental health have significantly improved. I am also gainfully employed, saving, and developing a plan to be self-reliant with stable housing. Most important of all, I am reconnecting with my cherished family and close friends."

This past year marked a powerful milestone for our agency—and, more importantly, for the women and children who come to us seeking safety, stability, and hope. In a time when homelessness has increased and affordable housing remains out of reach for so many people, we took a bold and deeply meaningful step forward. We opened a new transitional home for women and children, designed not just to provide housing, but to foster true healing and long-term change.

For the people who walk through our doors, homelessness is rarely just about the absence of a roof. It is often the result of trauma, loss, domestic violence, economic instability, poor health, and a lack of support. Our new transitional home was created with this reality in mind. It is a place where women and children can finally exhale—where they are safe, seen, and surrounded by care.



This new home, Grace House, offers residents the time and space they need to rebuild their lives. Families can stay while working toward stability, supported every step of the way by on-site services tailored to their individual needs. Case management, counseling, life-skills development, employment support, and parenting resources are all available, both on- and off-site.

This holistic approach allows women to focus not just on surviving, but on truly moving forward.

Within these walls, children have a place to sleep peacefully, to do homework at the kitchen table, and to simply be kids again. Mothers have the opportunity to set goals, access support, and rediscover their own strength. What may look like an

ordinary home from the outside is, on the inside, a space filled with courage, resilience, and possibility.

Opening this home was no small feat. It required vision, determination, and the collective belief that women and children experiencing homelessness deserve more than temporary solutions—they deserve dignity, opportunity, and a real

chance at a better future. This milestone was made possible because of the unwavering support of our community. Donors, volunteers, partners, and advocates came together to say, "Yes, this matters."

As we reflect on the past year, we are filled with gratitude and hope. Gratitude for everyone who believed in this project and helped make it a reality. Hope because we see, every day, what happens when women are given support instead of judgment, and when children are given stability instead of uncertainty.

This new transitional home represents more than bricks and mortar. It represents our intention that we will continue to stand alongside homeless women and children, meeting them where they are and walking with them toward a brighter, more secure future. Together, we are not just opening doors—we are opening new beginnings.


