30 YEARS OF SERVING THE COMMUNITY



Every day, the residents get jobs, save money, and learn coping skills to change their lives forever.

Thirty years ago, Lake County Haven opened its doors to provide shelter, safety, food, and guidance to homeless women and children. Much has changed in the world since then, but what hasn't changed is our commitment to homeless women and children. Our mission is to empower homeless women and their children to achieve permanent, independent living. Our vision is that our residents will never be homeless again.

Peg Bradley, one of the founders of LCH, marvels that the agency she helped start is now celebrating 30 years. "I just can't help but think of all the people whose lives have been touched by Lake County Haven," Bradley said. "I think of all of the staff who work day in and day out to support and guide the women and the hundreds and hundreds of volunteers and donors who have given so much of their time and resources."

Lake County Haven, with two shelters and seven transitional housing sites, has provided a safe, warm home, nutritious food, and life-changing services since its opening 30 years ago. Every day, the residents get jobs, save money, and learn coping skills to change their lives forever.



LCH has grown steadily to meet the needs of the community. It now operates two shelters, Hope House and Renewal House, and multiple units of transitional housing. A team of case managers works alongside residents to help them overcome any challenge and get back on their feet.

“We are eternally grateful to all our supporters for making this work possible,” Executive Director Laura Sabino stated. “All of us join forces together and we are able to help women and families transition from homelessness, poverty, and despair to safety, stability, and a happy, healthy future.” ♥

The founders of Lake County Haven opened the shelter within five months of their initial meeting. This small group did all the work, from finding a shelter to cleaning it, making the beds, and stocking the cupboards.

“Most of the people who started Lake County Haven had life circumstances within the first five or six years that took us away from the area,” Bradley said. “In some ways, I think that was good because the community took it over. Libertyville and all of Lake County have just embraced Lake County Haven over the last 30 years.”

As a Haven resident explains, "The Haven gave me and my son a warm bed, food on our plates, and a future."

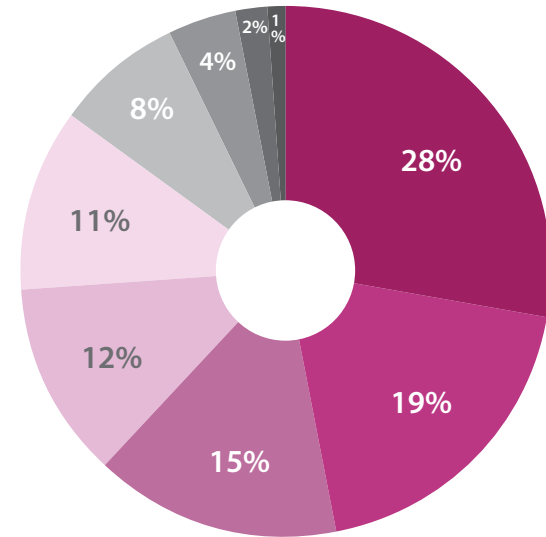
2022 Operating Year
